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DAY 1

Lakes of Killarney and The Gap of Dunloe

Ready for the adventure of a lifetime? Grab your backpack and hop on a shuttle from your hotel to **Ross Castle**, where your guide and fellow explorers await! Kickstart your day with a **boat ride** through the serene **Lakes of Killarney**, soaking up the stunning views and fascinating history shared by your guide.

Once ashore, it's time to lace up your hiking boots and hit the trail through **Black Valley** and into **The Gap of Dunloe**, the most famous glaciated valley in Ireland. After all that trekking, you'll have worked up quite an appetite for a delicious lunch and maybe a cheeky pint of Guinness at **Kate Kearney's Cottage**.

As the sun sets, rest your head at the luxurious **Loch Lein Country House**. Relax and enjoy your stay at this elegant Country House tucked away in the unspoilt beauty of **Killarney's Lake District**. This hidden treasure, nestled on the northern shore of Killarney's great lake, Loch Lein, offers magnificent views of the **McGillicuddy Reeks**.

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DAY 2

Carrauntoohil

Start your day off with a delicious breakfast, packed with locally sourced produce. With your belly full and energy restored, it's time to tackle the ultimate challenge: **conquering Ireland's tallest mountain, Carrauntoohil, via the awe-inspiring The Devil's Ladder.** This challenging climb is not for the faint of heart, but the reward of breathtaking views from the country's highest point makes it all worthwhile.

Fill up on scrumptious Irish comfort food, and swap stories with fellow adventurers and friendly locals, reminiscing about today's epic journey. It's the perfect place to rejuvenate those tired bones!



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DAY 3

Caragh Lake and The Windy Gap

And so the adventure continues! Our day starts off with a **canoe ride** through the majestic **Caragh Lake**, leading us to a secluded island. We'll dock there for a breather, and refuel on a delicious picnic lunch, bursting with classic Irish flavors sourced from local hotspots.

Once back on the lake's shore, we will swap our paddles for hiking boots once again! Following the famous **Kerry Way** trail, we will trek over the **Windy Gap** and into the picturesque village of **Glenbeigh**.

With **The Tower's Hotel** as our base, you are free to spend your evening as you wish! Take a leisurely sunset walk along the stunning **Rossbeigh beach** or get your adrenaline pumping with a majestic **horseback ride** through the waves! Savor a pint of Guinness while tapping your feet to some live Irish music. Keep your eyes peeled for shooting stars above and join a local astronomy expert for a stargazing stroll through the **Kerry DARK Sky Reserve**! This evening is yours to design!!

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DAY 4

The Kerry Way to Cahersiveen

On the second-to-last day of your epic journey, we will set off on foot, **trekking** along the **Kerry Way**, one of the most awe-inspiring trails in Ireland. **Cnoc Na dTobar**, meaning Hill of The Wells, is an ancient pilgrim mountain. Even before Christian times, in the 5th-century Cnoc Na dTobar was a place of celebrations for Celtic festivals.

Hold onto your hats because we're saving the best for last! Get ready to rest your head at the **Quinlan & Cooke Guesthouse**, the grand finale of this epic adventure. Nestled in the heart of Cahersiveen on Kerry's stunning **Wild Atlantic Way**, this boutique townhouse is the perfect place to call home while you explore the breathtaking beauty of South Kerry. Originally a seafood hotspot, owner Kate Cooke transformed QC's into a cozy retreat that combines luxury and homely charm.

But wait, there's more! After a quick explore of your home for the night, off we go to the nearby **seacliffs of Cuascrom**. Take in the wonder of the Atlantic Ocean as the sun begins to dip and we prepare your dinner for this evening..a **clifftop barbeque**! Feeling brave? Why not try your hand at some **seacliff climbing** with your host while you wait! Then, once your belly is sufficiently full, sit back and listen to the melodies of local traditional musicians as they jam by the campfire.

DAY 5

Cahersiveen to Skellig Michael

The final leg of this epic trip of a lifetime is upon us and it sees us make a **trip by boat to the historic Skellig Michael**. This famous location is one of only two **UNESCO World Heritage Sites in the Republic of Ireland**. One of the most mysterious and enchanting of our Kerrys attractions, this floating pyramid of sandstone has been home to some of the earliest monastic settlements in Ireland as well as providing sanctuary to fantastic numbers of bird life in the area, like the Puffin. Follow in the monks' footsteps by climbing the 618 steps to the island's summit, where you will find St Fionan's monastery, one of the earliest foundations in the country. The monks who lived there prayed and slept in beehive-shaped huts made of stone, many of which remain to this day. Skellig Michael is also very famously featured in the recent **Star Wars** films for any of you movie buffs in the group!

After our boat ride back to the mainland, it is nearly time to conclude our adventure. A shuttle bus will be provided to Killarney, Dingle or Kerry Airport after a final farewell dinner.
